Following the advice of our tree warden the Town Council wishes to emphasise the need to replace any trees that are removed and also to replant the transplanted tree immediately. The Town Council recognises the benefit of trees in regulating air quality and managing ground water levels. The tree warden has expressed deep concern at the potential loss of the Portuguese Laurel and the Rowan.

With regard to the building works it is good to see the school endeavouring to improve the quality of the learning environment and the Town Council has no objection to this proposal, which will increase the lifespan of this prominent building close to one of the town's gateways.

18. To receive feedback from Cllr S Raywood about his recent course on 'Planning Applications from a Local Council Perspective.

Councillor S. Raywood reported to the Committee that attended a training course organised by the Gloucestershire Association of Parish and Town Councils held at the Parish Hall, Highnam on Tuesday 6th November 2018. The *Planning applications from the perspective of town and parish councils* training course was delivered by Andrea Pellegram MRTPI of Andrea Pellegram Ltd and Planning Local. The committee was updated that the Committee is implementing good practice including in the area of Pre-Application engagement. Councillor S. Raywood also informed the Committee that Planning Local provides a membership service at a cost of £100 per year for Local Councils.

19. To receive an update on the progress of the Town Council's response to the Borough Plan Preferred Options consultation and to agree further actions

A working group met on 31st October to discuss each of the 84 policies in the Preferred Options document. A list of questions and comments were formulated and these were put to the Borough Officer at the consultation evening on 8th November. A brief overview of the questions and answers was given.

The working party will meet again on the 21st November at 6.00pm, to formulate the Town Council's response to the Preferred Options, so that they can be signed-off at the next Planning Committee meeting, for submission before the deadline on 30th November.

- The deadline for responses to the Preferred Options plan is **30th November 2018**
- Assuming Borough Executive approval, there will a public consultation on the Regeneration SPD in the town Hall on 13th December 2018.
- The JCS consultation is now open. The closing date is 11th January 2019.
- The understanding from the Borough is that it is early days for the JCS Ashchurch Masterplan but it will move forward at pace, so we can probably expected there to be a public consultation early in the New Year.
- Planning reform: supporting the high street and increasing the delivery of new homes is a national consultation, some of which is very relevant to Tewkesbury. The closing date for this is the 14th January 2019.

22. To receive an update on the committee budget for 2019-2020 and agree on necessary modifications

Following the development of a draft Committee budget in September 2018 the Committee discussed amendments to account for Community Infrastructure Levy and the setting of a Contingency in line with a decision of a meeting of the full Town Council.
