**SPECIAL EVENT NOTICE
ROAD CLOSURE AND RESTRICTIONS
A38 HIGH STREET (TEWKESBURY TOWN) TEWKESBURY
BOROUGH**

Gloucestershire County Council with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order to close and restrict temporarily under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994) part of the A38 High Street from its junction with Quay Street to its junction with Church Road for a distance of approximately 400 metres.

There will be no parking or waiting permitted throughout the duration of the event.

The Council is satisfied that the use of the road should be prohibited and restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event namely the Three Seasonal Food and Crafts Markets 2019.

The road falls within the Tewkesbury Town in the Tewkesbury Borough within the County of Gloucestershire.

The Order comes into force on 28th April 2019. There are three events taking place on 28th April 2019, 21st July 2019 and 20th October 2019 at each event the road will be closed and restricted from 04:00 hours until 20:00.

Alternative Route – as signed on site.

Pedestrian access to premises on or next to the road and emergency access will be maintained.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND RESTRICTION OF A38 HIGH STREET
(TEWKESBURY TOWN) TEWKESBURY BOROUGH
SPECIAL EVENT ORDER 2019

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for A38 High Street from its junction with Quay Street to its junction with Church Road for a distance of approximately 400 metres within Tewkesbury Borough ("the Road") and having obtained the necessary consent from the Secretary of State for Transport for the Order to permit the closure of the Road more than once in a calendar year ("the Consent") is satisfied that traffic along the Road should be prohibited and restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event namely the Three Seasonal Food and Crafts Markets 2019.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994), hereby makes with the Consent the following Order:-

1. No person shall park nor wait or cause anyone to park nor wait along the Road throughout the duration of the event;
2. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed along the Road
3. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the Roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order

4. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful for a Vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road
5. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful for a Vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road
6. The Road falls in the Tewkesbury Town in the Tewkesbury Borough within the County of Gloucestershire
7. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th April 2019 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding three days
8. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure and Restriction of A38 High Street (Tewkesbury Town) Tewkesbury Borough Special Event Order 2019"

9. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
