Re: A46 Worcestershire bends and junction's improvement work

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming improvement work on the A46. This work will be carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Kier.

What we're doing and why?

We'll be renewing road markings and signs along the A46 between Teddington Hands and Evesham. Our work has been designed to improve the safety of the road user, whilst ensuring the bends and junctions are consistently signed and marked. The completed work will ensure the safety of the road user is maintained at all times.

When will this work take place?

Our work at this location has already started, and we expect to complete by 6 May 2022. The early part of our work is being delivered within shared traffic management which has been designed to reduce disruption. The majority of our work will be carried out under day time lane closures, and temporary traffic signals. We'll also work in phases which has been designed to reduce the impact on road users and local economy.

To complete aspects of our work safely, the A46 will be closed overnight between Teddington Hands and Beckford on 19 April, 20 April, 21 April and 22 April, 9pm to 6am.

No restrictions will be in place throughout the Easter Bank Holiday Weekend.

What does this mean for you?

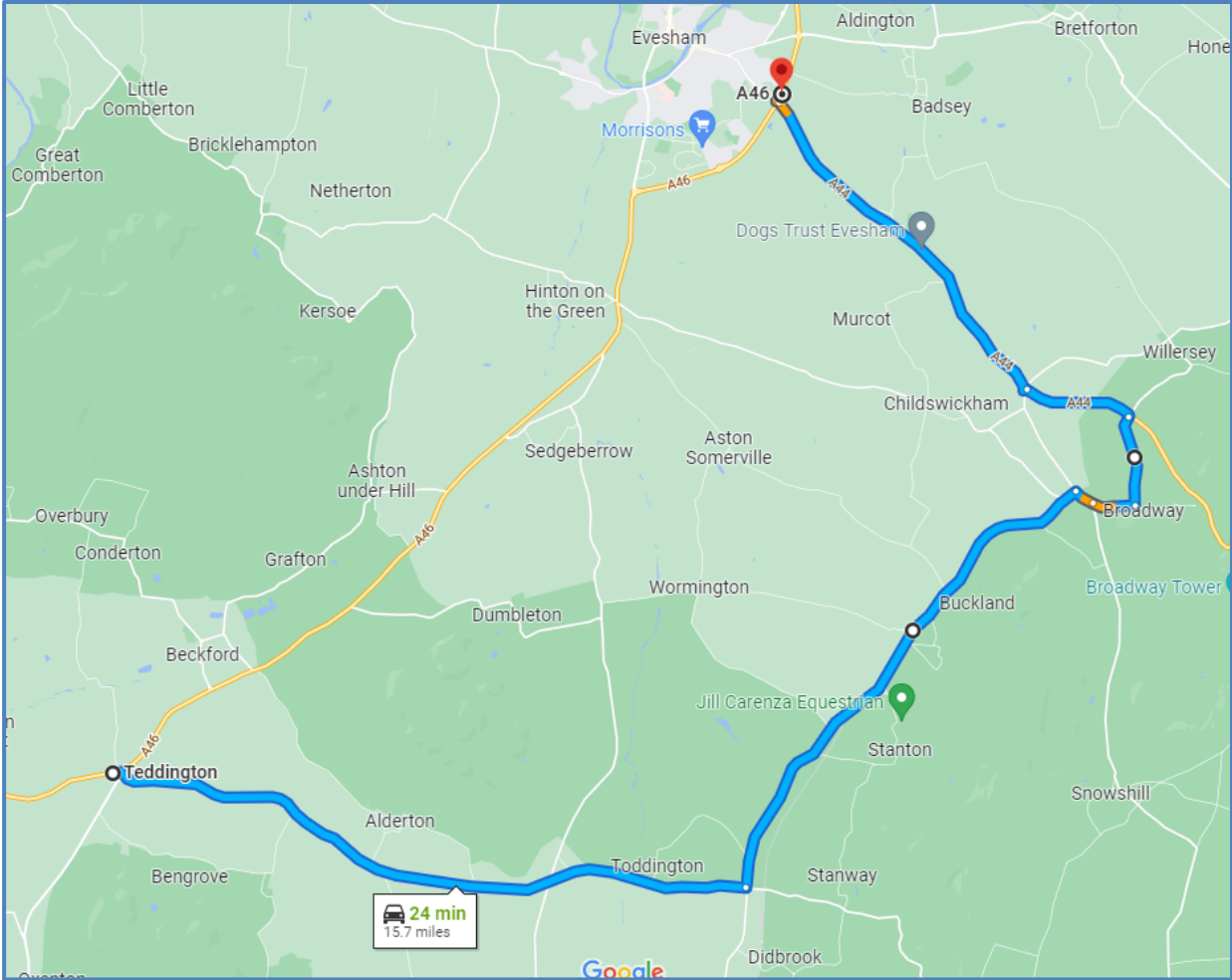
During closures, a fully signed diversion will be in place as below. Please plan ahead, and allow additional time for your journey.

I'd also like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption to those living close to our work. We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels and additional lighting to minimise the impact.

Access to frontages that fall directly within our traffic management or road closures will be maintained throughout.

Our work is subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

We'll return to complete resurfacing of the A46 between Teddington Hands and Beckford. Our work is currently planned for Spring 2022. We'll provide further updates over the next few weeks. Once complete, this will ensure we continue to provide a safer road at this location.
