Volunteers at Bookworm Tewkesbury are delighted to announce that we now provide a 'bra bank', a collection point for unwanted bras. The bras collected will go to 'Bras Against Breast Cancer'. Through their bra recycling scheme and network of bra banks vital funds are raised for pioneering breast cancer research.

The same bras also help to support small businesses in developing countries in Africa and around the world. The project prevents these bras going into landfill before giving them a new lease of life in countries such as Togo, Ghana and Kenya, where bras remain expensive to produce locally. Such ventures provide income for families in developing countries whilst providing employment for people living in the UK. Any bras that are genuinely beyond redemption are dismantled and disposed of properly.
