Tour of Britain – Friday 9th September 2022

- What:** Road Closures and Parking Restrictions to facilitate the Tour of Britain cycle race.
One way Traffic Restrictions (High Street and Oldbury Road only)
- Where:** Church Street / Gloucester Road / Barton Street / Mill Street and St Mary's Lane Tewkesbury
High Street / Oldbury Road Tewkesbury
- When:** **Friday 9th September – Road Closures (see below) 03:00 to 14:00**
Friday 9th September – No Parking from 00:01 to Midnight
Friday 9th September – One Way Restrictions 03:00 to 14:00

Gloucestershire will host the 2022 Tour of Britain with support from the County Council this autumn. Stage six of the Tour will start in Tewkesbury and finish near Gloucester Docks and will be held on **Friday 9th September 2022.**

Road Closures

The road closures will include Church Street, Gloucester Road, Barton Street, Mill Street, St Marys Road /Lane and Post Office Lane.

Church Street and Gloucester Road

These roads will be closed to traffic between 03:00 and 14:00 on Friday 9th September between the High Street and Lower Lode Lane. No access to frontages by vehicles will be available during these times.

Barton Street

Barton Street will be closed by a rolling roadblock to all traffic from 10:15am and will be reopened shortly after the race starts at 11am.

Mill Street and St Mary's Lane

The junctions of Mill Street and St Marys Road from Church Street will be closed from 03:00 until 14:00. Access will be available via St Marys Lane near the Hyde Coffee and Tea house until 8.30am at which point the road will be closed until the race has commenced. Residents needing to leave during this time will need to make alternative arrangements for parking outside of this area.

Parking Restrictions

There will be strictly no parking on Gloucester Road, Church Street and Barton Street from 00:01 until the race has commenced and the vehicles and barriers have been removed.

Any cars remaining within this area will be towed to Oldbury Road Car Park for collection by the owners.

One Way Traffic Restrictions

High Street and Oldbury Road

A one way traffic restriction will be in place along High Street and Oldbury Road from 03:00 to 14:00 along the High Street and Oldbury Road. Traffic travelling north will be able to access the High Street from Barton Street and vehicles travelling south will be diverted away from the High Street and along Oldbury Road rejoining at Barton Street. There will be a short period of time when the High Street will be completely closed to traffic at the start of the race.

Diversion

An official diversion route will be signposted during the closure times. Signs will also be in place for the One Way System.

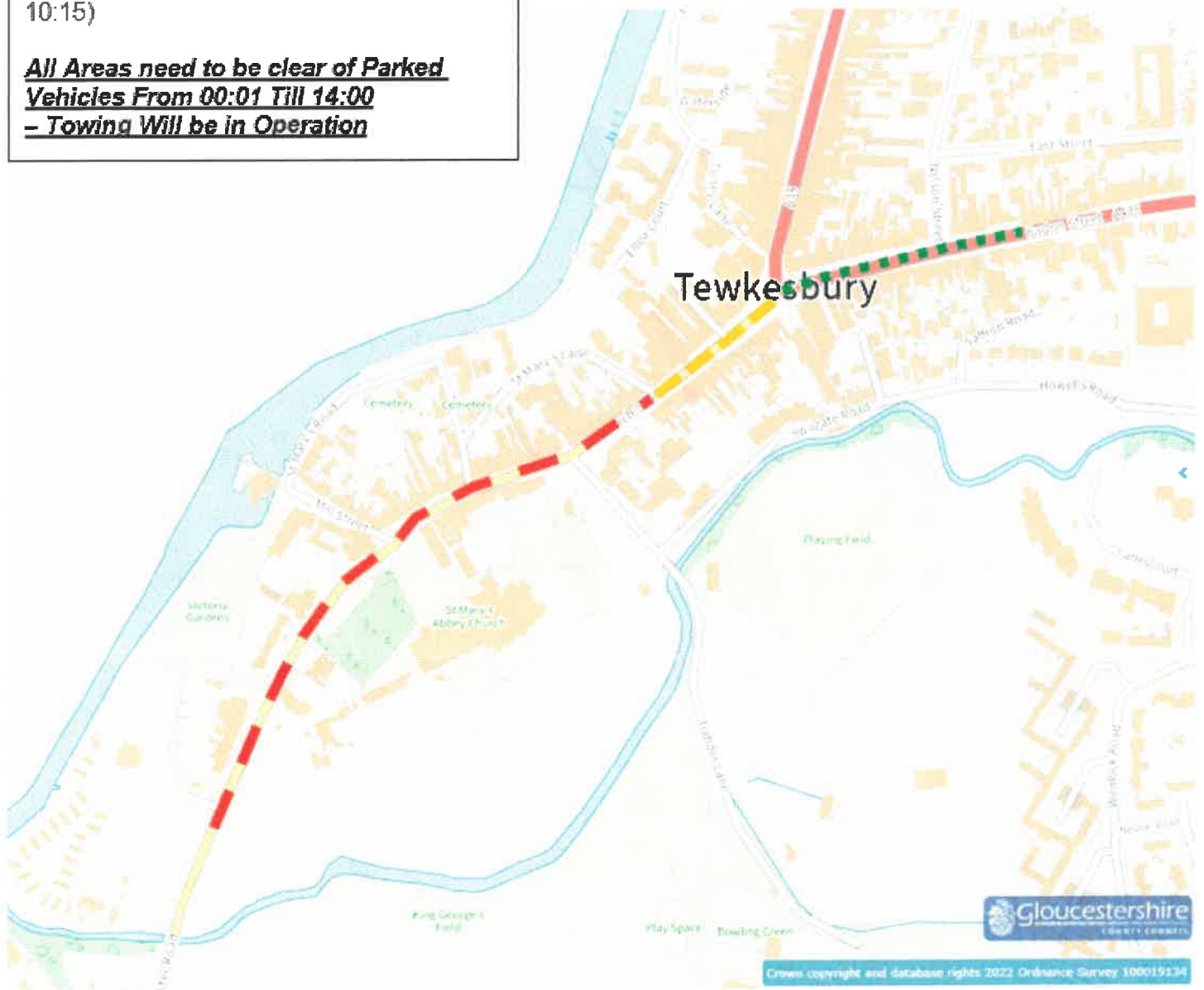

- Towing Will be in Operation



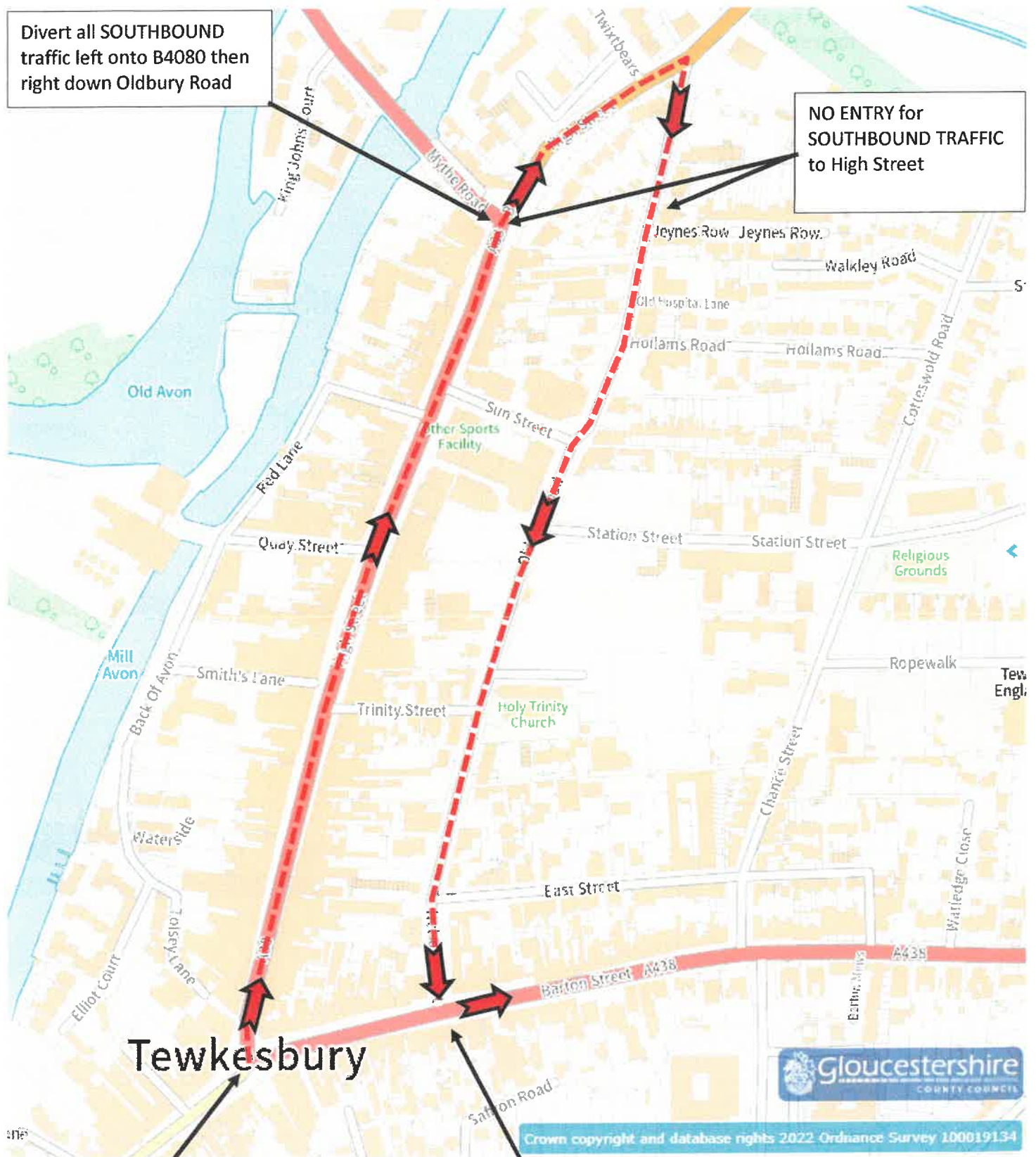
ONE WAY TRAFFIC
