Re: M5 Southbound junction 8 junction 9 targeted resurfacing

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming maintenance work along the M5. This work will be carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Colas.

What we're doing and why? What are the benefits?

We'll be carrying out essential targeted resurfacing work on the M5 southbound between junction 8 and junction 9. The work has been identified following a recent inspection of this network. The completed work will provide a smoother surface and safer road.

When will this work take place?

We'll work overnight on **Tuesday 20 September 2022, 10pm to 6am**. To complete our work safely we will work within a full closure of the M5 southbound between Junction 8 and junction 9.

What does this mean for you?

During closures, we'll provide a fully signed diversion route - please see below for further details.

Access will be maintained throughout for the emergency services.

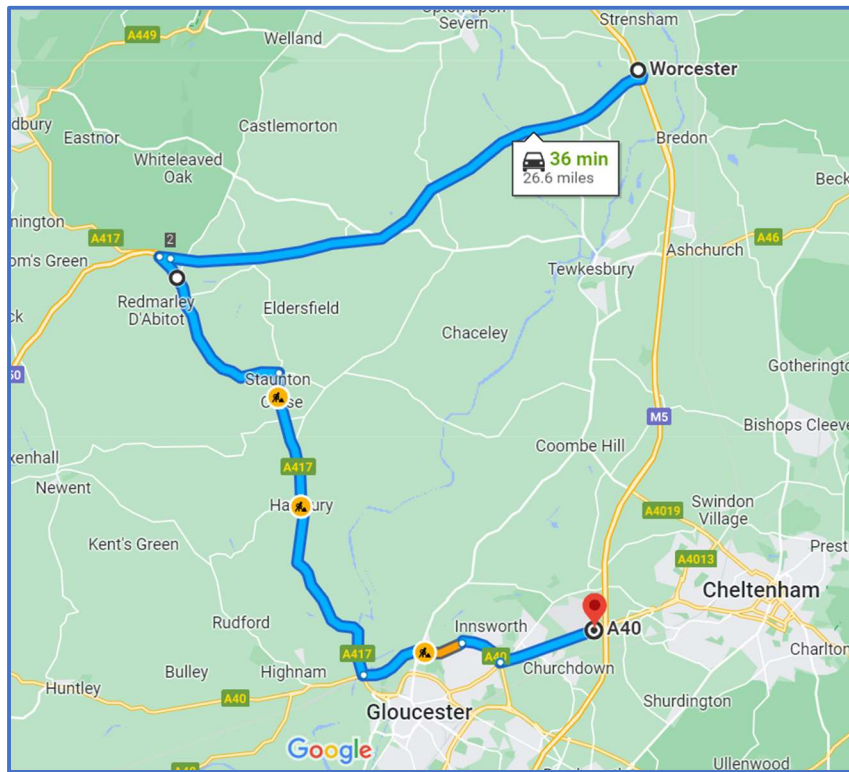
Please note, our planned work may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
