i. Back of Avon moorings:

Proposed work to replace moorings:

Details of the properties of GRP panels were shared and the advice that they are by far the best material for anti-slip and longevity.

One quote has been received to date and ANT are also due to send one for the proposed work. The advice from the Environment Agency about when it would be acceptable to carry out the work was reviewed and the need for a FRAP (Flood Risk Activity Permit) was noted. It was discussed that the proposals should be shared with the conservation officer at TBC when appropriate.

Action - Admin Assistant to start the process for work to be put to tender to obtain further quotes. In addition, to complete a pre-application planning form and return it to TBC.

ii. Moorings adjacent to St Marys Lane Car Park:

Admin Assistant advised that TBC confirmed there are currently no plans to alter anything at St Marys Lane Car Park.

Feedback on the state of the wall was shared, following a site visit by an approved contactor.

Action - Cllr Danter took an action to contact MVS to ask them to take photos of the wall from the river.

Admin Assistant to contact TBC to highlight the disrepair of the wall if required.

iii. Priors Court moorings:

The willow trees were cut back in August.

A possible void under the footpath was identified when reviewing the surveys. Following advice from TBC Building Control, Cheltenham Borough Council was notified.
