GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCILTEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND RESTRICTION OF U47802 QUEENS ROAD (TEWKESBURY TOWN)(TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2025

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for the U47802 Queens Road from its junction with Warwick Place to its junction with Devonshire Place for a distance of approximately 180 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall stop nor wait or cause anyone to stop nor wait along the Road throughout the duration of the said works;
- Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
- 4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
- The Road falls within Tewkesbury in the Tewkesbury Borough within the County of Gloucestershire;
- This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of September Two Thousand and Twenty Five and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is earlier;
- 7. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Road Closure U47802 Queens Road (Tewkesbury Town)(Tewkesbury Borough) Order 2025"
- 8. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or any diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the said works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
